Yardage:

Fabric 1: 1 yard (We used a bright dark green)

Fabric 2: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard (We used a medium bright green)

Fabric 3: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (We used a bright hot pink)

Fabric 4: 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (We used a light pink – this is the background)

Yardage amounts include a little extra for cutting errors.

Cutting:

Fabric 1

4 strips @ 5 $\frac{5}{8}$ "	cut 28 squares	cut the diagonal to yield 56 triangles
1 strip @ 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ "	cut 14 squares	

Fabric 2

2 strips @ 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ "	cut 12 squares	cut the diagonal to yield 24 triangles
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Fabric 3

1 strip @ 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ "	cut 6 squares	cut BOTH diagonals to yield 24 triangles
3 strips @ 3 $\frac{5}{8}$ "	cut 28 squares	cut BOTH diagonals to yield 112 triangles

Fabric 4 (background)

1 strip @ 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ "	cut 6 squares	cut BOTH diagonals to yield 24 triangles
3 strips @ 3 $\frac{5}{8}$ "	cut 28 squares	cut BOTH diagonals to yield 112 triangles
8 strips @ 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ "	cut 56 rectangles 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " by 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ "	
4 strips @ 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ "	cut 56 squares	
reserve the remaining background fabric for borders
