A note about sign-ups & a few changes to be aware of:

So that everyone has an opportunity to participate in some classes, such as Ladies Day In, Sew Fun w/Hyde, and Finishing school, etc...we will be limiting sign-ups for just 2 bees per person during signups, one week after signups you can add any additional classes that you wish.

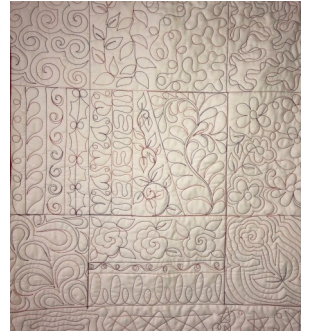
Beginning Machine Quilting

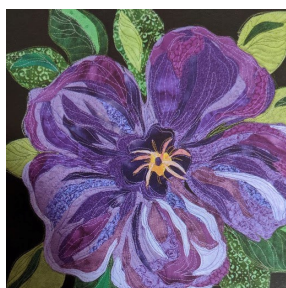

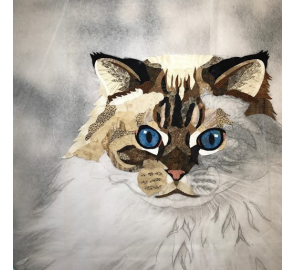

Let Keith show you the fast, easy and fun steps of preparing the turned-edge appliqué shapes and stitching them down invisibly by machine. The cute flower pattern with large, easy-to-learn shapes will let you practice the essential skills for both inside and outside curves and both inside and outside points. Preparing the appliqué shapes - Keith will show you the tips and techniques for turning edges over a leave-in appliqué foundation and glue-basting them down. Stitching them down - Keith will help set up your machine for the best invisible appliqué stitch and show you the tips and techniques for positioning your shapes and stitching them down.

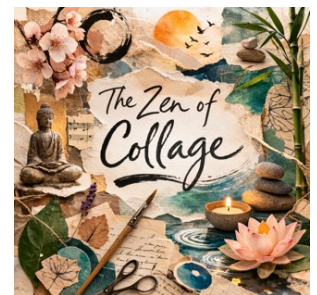

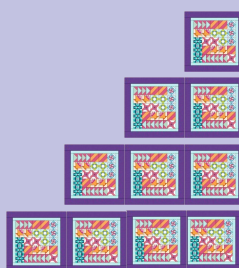
